

Kasatsa Onsen, Ganma

The place I'd like to introduce is Kusatsu Onsen Town, which is well known for its hot springs. It's located the mountains in north-western Gunma.

Of the several hot springs there, the one I especially like is Kamenoi Hotel Kusatsu Yubatake. It's a hotel night near the hot springs in the middle of town. You can eat Gunma's famous foods there, like Okkirikomi and Himokawa udon.

The hot spring has the largest <u>volume</u> of water of any naturally <u>flowing</u> spring in Japan. It is a natural hot spring that flows directly from the source, and it <u>boasts</u> powerful <u>sterilizing</u> properties.

Masa, Tochigi

Nasu doesn't get that many tourists, but it's a wonderful place where you can feel close to nature. It's about three hours from Tokyo. I think it would be a good idea to <u>hire</u> a car, because Nasu is a rural area, with many outdoor activities.

I personally recommend Nasu Highland Park, and Hotel Epinard Nasu. Nasu Highland Park is a <u>dog-friendly</u> theme park. There are over 40 different rides and attractions, some of which dogs can ride too! Hotel Epinard Nasu is a luxurious onsen-resort hotel. 












Doa's Station, Gamma

The place I'd like to introduce is Doai Station, located to the north of Minakami town, Gunma. It is known as Japan's deepest train station. It's an <u>unmanned</u> station, but there is a cafe above it.

The platform for the transfer line is located about 70 meters underground, so passengers must climb up a long staircase of 462 steps to get to the <u>surface</u>. I went there before and it was a little bit scary but really amazing! I'm sure that you will enjoy it as well.


